

Freedom of Expression: International Law and the Practice in Myanmar

Online Course

Interested in learning more about international standards on freedom of expression and how they are applied and avoided in Myanmar?



This nine-week online course, to be conducted in English, involves weekly one and one-half hour interactive lectures, discussions, background readings and an opportunity to interact with others who share your interest.

The first six weeks will focus on international human rights standards on freedom of expression, media freedom and digital rights. The next three weeks will examine the legal environment for freedom of expression in Myanmar both before and since the 2021 coup.
